- supply written references from teachers and community members*
- provide specific details on future goals
- are active and involved supporters of school and community*
- demonstrate financial need for assistance

PLEASE NOTE: * Applicants must supply supporting documentation and will be screened for eligibility and shortlisted for interview (only those applicants selected for interview will be contacted).

ABOUT THE SELECTION COMMITTEE:
